LQ < 1 Indicates the opportunity to develop business and/or an occupation in the local area if needed.

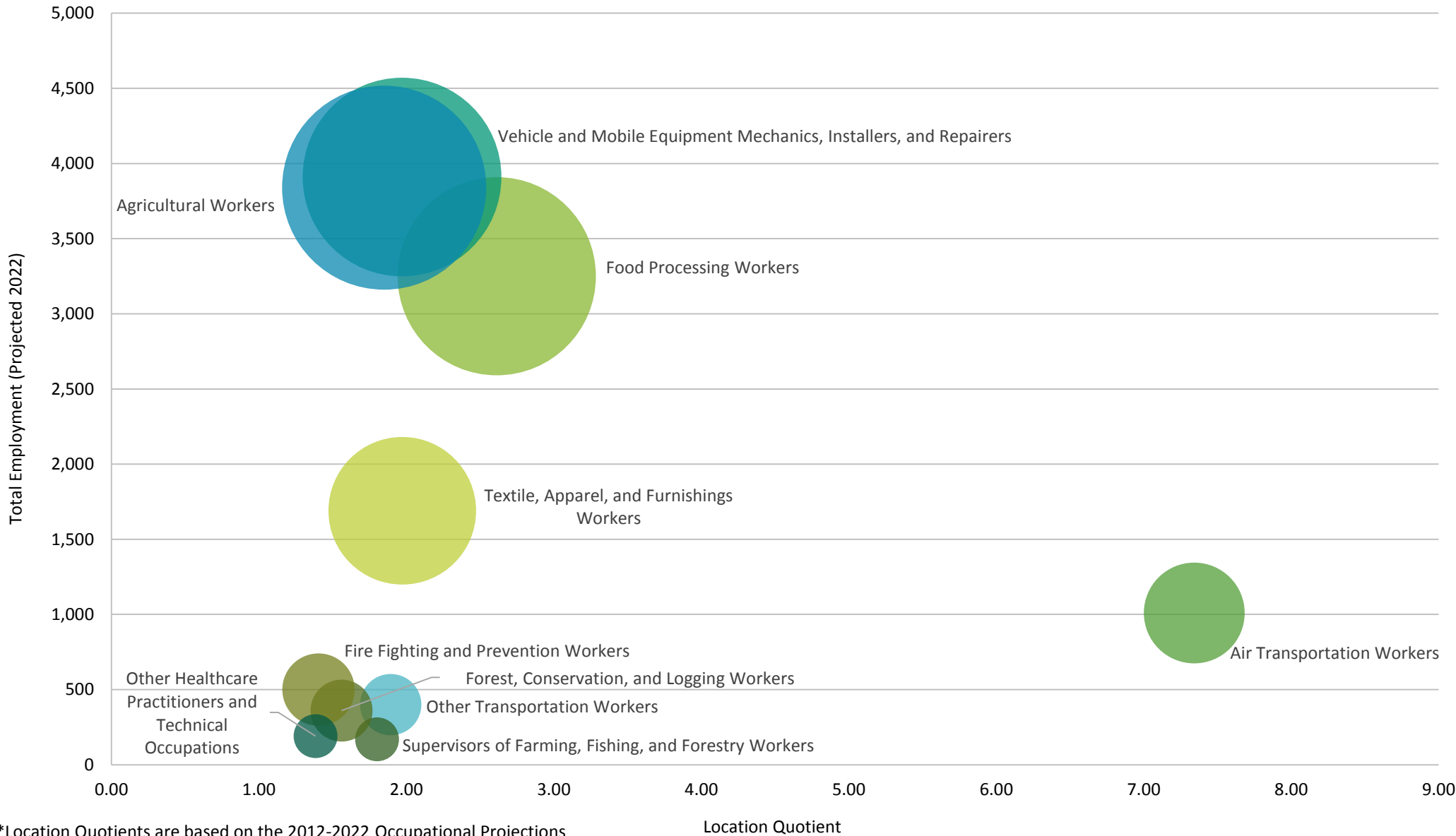
